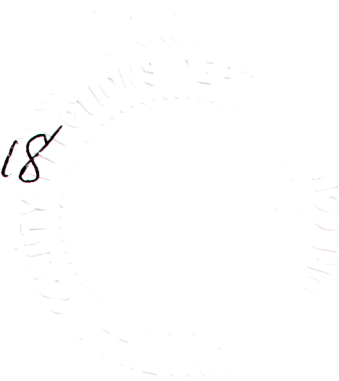

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS 607.010, the Board of Commissioners received a petition from property owners that own property in an unincorporated area of the county, that they desire to form a new livestock district to be known as Salmon Point Livestock District; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by more than 6 electors within the boundary of the proposed district; and

WHEREAS the proposed district contains not less than 2,000 acres; and

WHEREAS the classes of livestock not be permitted to run at large within the proposed livestock district are animals of the bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine; and

WHEREAS on December 20, 2017, the Board of Commissioners adopted Order No. BCC2017-081, describing the boundary of the territory to be known as the Salmon Point Livestock District, specifying the class of livestock not permitted to run at large within the proposed district, setting a hearing on February 7, 2018 for the proposed formation, and directed that notice of the hearing be published in the East Oregonian; and

WHEREAS on March 21, 2018, the Board of Commissioners adopted Order No. BCC2018-013, calling for an election on the formation of Salmon Point Livestock District; and

WHEREAS on April 17, 2018, an election on the formation of Salmon Point Livestock District was held, the results of which were 23 votes in favor, and 43 votes in opposition.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners orders that:

1. Results of the April 17, 2018 election on the formation of the Salmon Point Livestock District are accepted.

2. Due to the results of the election, the petition for the formation of the Salmon Point Livestock District is denied.
