Previously, the Board initiative the process for the formation and set this first public hearing for the purpose of boundaries of the district and those properties would be benefited by the district. <u>Terry Case</u>, PO Box 245 Helix Oregon. He is the Secretary/Treasurer of the Helix Rural Fire Protection District and also served on the Board under the Intergovernmental Agreement. He feels this is best for the community to provide better fire service and allow for combining the districts.

Mr. Olsen pointed out map as projected on the room monitors shows the proposed boundaries. And, Mr. Case added forming the new district would also add the City of Athena into the district.
