# Budget Order 2022-08 SHERIFF SPECIAL PROJECTS: EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANTS

The <u>Emergency Management Grants program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in State Revenue of \$86,632, an increase in Transfers In of \$10,000, a decrease in Materials & Services of \$25,500, a decrease in Capital Outlay of \$57,582 and an increase in Contingency of \$9,450.

### Budget Order 2022-11 **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

The <u>Economic Development Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$100,000 and an increase Materials & Services of \$100,000.

### Budget Order 2022-12 2050 PLAN: CENTRAL WATER PROJECT

The <u>Central Water Project Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$2,000,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$2,000,000.

# Budget Order 2022-13 **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RESERVE**

The **Economic Development Reserve Program** requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$100,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$100,000.

### Budget Order 2022-14 FACILITIES RESERVE

The <u>Facilities Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$500,000 and an increase in Capital Outlay of \$500,000.

### Budget Order 2022-15 PUBLIC WORKS

The <u>Public Works Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of 2,000,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$2,000,000.

### Budget Order 2022-16 GENERAL COUNTY

The <u>General County Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers Out of \$10,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$10,000.

### Budget Order 2022-17 GF-COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

The <u>Communicable Disease Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$1,100,000, an increase in Personnel Services of \$500,000 and an increase in Materials and Services of \$600,000.

### Budget Order 2022-18 **GF-HEALTH DEPT.**

The <u>Health Department Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$40,000 and an increase in Materials and Services of \$40,000.

### Budget Order 2022-19 PARKS PROGRAM

The <u>Parks Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$150,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$150,000.

### Budget Order 2022-20 HUMAN SERVICES-SE63 PEER PROGRAM

The <u>SE63 Peer Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$214,000, a decrease in Personnel Services of \$260,000, an increase in Materials and Services of \$503,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$29,000

### Budget Order 2022-21 HUMAN SERVICES-SE66 TREATMENT

The <u>SE66 Treatment Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$76,000, a decrease in Personnel Services of \$177,000, an increase in Materials and Services of \$408,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$155,000.

### Budget Order 2022-22 HUMAN SERVICES-SE66 IDPF PROGRAM

The <u>SE66 IDPF Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$14,000, a decrease in Personnel Services of \$10,000 and an increase in Materials and Services of \$24,000.

### Budget Order 2022-23 HUMAN SERVICES-SE80 GAMBLING PREVENTION

The <u>SE80 Gambling Prevention Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$22,000 and an increase in Materials and Services of \$22,000.

### Budget Order 2022-24 HUMAN SERVICES-2145 ALCOHOL / MH TAX

The <u>2145 Alcohol / MH Tax Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$12,000, a decrease in Personnel Services of \$12,000, an increase in Materials and Services of \$116,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$92,000.

### Budget Order 2022-25 HUMAN SERVICES-SCHOOL BASED MH CENTER

The **School Based MH Program** requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$35,000, a decrease in Personnel Services of \$13,000 and an increase in Materials and Services of \$48,000.

### Budget Order 2022-29 ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION

The <u>Assessment and Taxation Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$50,000, an increase in Local Revenue of \$250,000 and an increase in Materials and Services of \$300,000.

### Budget Order 2022-31 CAPITAL PURCHASES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

The <u>Capital Purchases Management Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$100,000, an increase in Transfers In of \$140,000 and an increase in Capital Outlay of \$240,000.
