2021-2022 Supplemental Budgets

Scheduled for October 6, 2021

Three Supplemental Budgets and are scheduled for consideration on October 6, 2021. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2022-02 BICYCLE PATH

The <u>Bicycle Path Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$100,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$100,000.

Budget Order 2022-03 HUMAN SERVICES

The <u>Human Services Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$169,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$169,000.

Budget Order 2022-07 INMATE WELFARE (Commissary)

The <u>Inmate Welfare (Commissary) Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$123,000, and increase in Local Revenue of \$60,000, and increase in Materials & Services of \$145,000 and an increase n Contingency of \$38,000.
