2024-2025 Supplemental Budgets

Scheduled for February 5, 2025

Twelve Supplemental Budgets are scheduled for consideration on February 5, 2025. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2025- 22 General Fund – VOCA

The <u>General Fund – VOCA Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in State Revenue of \$55,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$55,000.

Budget Order 2025-23 Victim Witness - VOCA

The <u>Victim Witness- VOCA Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$55,000, and an increase in Contingency of \$55,000

Budget Order 2025-26 CARE

The <u>CARE Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$75,000, an increase in Material & Services of \$35,000 and an increase in Capital Outlay of \$40,000.

Budget Order 2025-27 Road District

The **Road District Program** requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$500,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$500,000.

Budget Order 2025-29 Infrastructure Reserve

The <u>Infrastructure Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$2,000,000, and an increase in Contingency of \$2,000,000.

Budget Order 2025-30 **Health Department**

The <u>Health Department Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$100,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$100,000.

Budget Order 2025-31 **Immunizations**

The <u>Immunizations Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$60,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$60,000.

Budget Order 2025-33 Fair Improvement

The <u>Fair Improvement Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Beginning Cash of \$550,000, and a decrease in Materials & Services of \$550,000.

Budget Order 2025-34 **Justice Reinvestment**

The <u>Justice Reinvestment Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$110,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$110,000.

Budget Order 2025-35 Nuisance Abatement

The <u>Nuisance Abatement Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$12,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$12,000.

Budget Order 2025-36 County Fair

The <u>County Fair Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$130,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$75,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$55,000.

Budget Order 2025-37 CARE Program

The <u>CARE Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$85,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$85,000.
