SUBJECT: Camping Fees

<p>Background: Harris Park is requesting an increase in the fee schedule for camping at Harris Park. The request is to raise camping fees from \$30 per night to \$35 per night and Cabin fees from \$45 per night to \$50 per night. Normally this request would be before the board prior to the budget year beginning for July implementation. That time frame would be difficult for the park since that would mean we would have a rate increase mid-season causing a great deal of confusion and potential problems with guests as well as with online reservations. We are asking for this fee increase to go into effect March 1 2025, this is when reservations open for camping for the 2025 season. WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners has ordained Ordinance No. 94-20, adopting a comprehensive fee ordinance for county services performed for the public;

WHEREAS ORS 203.115 permits the county governing body to set fees charged for county services and to amend the fees enacted;

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners desires to inform the public of all fees charged for County services;

WHEREAS certain fees for Harris Park are proposed to be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE the Board of Commissioners of Umatilla County ordains that the Comprehensive Fee Ordinance, No. 94-20, dated November 7, 1994, shall be further amended as follow (deleted words are ~~struck through~~ and added words are *italicized and underlined*):

§ 39.220 HARRIS PARK.
