## **Business Items**

- <u>Public Works Purchase</u> Presented by Tom Fellows, Umatilla County Public Works Director. The Public Works Department is requesting authority to purchase new radio repeater and antenna with hardware and installation for the Cabbage hill radio site. The old repeater system is outdated and no longer functions, so replacement is needed. Commissioner Timmons moved to approve the purchase of radio equipment from Comm-Tech Inc. in the amount of \$8,893.00. Seconded by Commissioner Shafer. Carried, 2-0.
- 2. <u>Road Maintenance Agreement</u> Presented by Tom Fellows, Umatilla County Public Works Director. The Public Works Department is requesting approval to grade approximately 8.2 miles of canal roads for the Bureau of Reclamation in the Hermiston Area. Chet Sater with the BOR contacted the department and made the request. Since this is not on right of way eligible for state

highway fund use the County must be reimbursed for all coats. Reimbursement will be made through Stanfield Irrigation District for all work. Have done these for different entities in the past. Commissioner Timmons moved to authorize to contract with BOR for canal road grading project. Seconded by Commissioner Shafer. Carried, 2-0.

- 3. <u>Copier Purchase</u> Presented by Dan Lonai, Umatilla County Administrative Services Director. The department is requesting permission to purchase a new color copier for the Records Office. The existing copier would be moved to the Hermiston Office so they can print 11x17 copies. Two proposals were received: Copiers Northwest \$6,013.33 and Canon Solutions \$7,813.48. They both bid the same Canon Copier. This Item has been budgeted for. Factoring in maintenance costs, the bid from Copiers Northwest is still lower. **Commissioner Timmons moved to approve the purchase from Copiers Northwest as outlined. Seconded by Commissioner Shafer. Carried, 2-0.**
- 4. <u>Program Subscription Purchase</u> Presented by Dan Lonai, Umatilla County Administrative Director. This program is an additional layer of security to our anti phishing system. It uses AI to help with identifying malicious emails and removes them from all county email accounts. It reduces staff time to monitor the email system and increases security. The cost for a four-year contract is \$9,510.65. Can also provide feedback to person reporting. Will pay using funding from another project that will be delayed to future year. Commissioner Timmons moved to approve purchase of a 4-year license for \$9,510.65. Seconded by Commissioner Shafer. Carried, 2-0.
- 5. <u>Pipeline Contract</u> Presented by Doug Olsen, County Counsel. Authorization is sought to contract with G6 Engineering LLC for controls integration services for the Central pipeline project. The proposal includes services and hardware. This is part of the budget for the project. Commissioner Shafer moved to authorize personal services contract with G6 Engineering LLC for control integration services in the amount of \$156,180.00. Seconded by Commissioner Timmons. Carried, 2-0.
