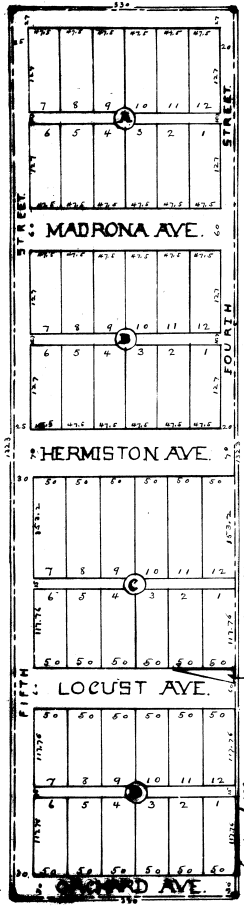


FIRST ADDITION
