NARRATIVE OF SURVEY
for
CARRIE SAMPSON

This survey was performed for the Umatilla Reservation Housing Authority as part of the 12-07 housing construction project.

The survey involved laying out a homesite tract based on a written description furnished by Pioneer Title Company of Pendleton, Oregon. Based on the aforementioned description, the North line of the tract was established on the Southerly right-of-way line of the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company's railroad right-of-way. The Southerly line was established on the East-West Centerline of Section 11, Township 2 North, Range 33 East, W. M. The West line of the tract was established as the West line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 11. The East line of the tract was established perpendicular to the East-West Centerline of said Section 11 a distance of 82.50 feet (when measured along the East-West Centerline of said Section 11) East of the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 11.

The right-of-way of County Road No. 747 was excepted out in the tract description.
