Memorandum field notes

Martin to Crossman - Sec. 3, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. 7 M.

From a point 30 ft. East of the  $\frac{E}{4}$  cor. of Sec. 3 T 4 N., R. 28 E. W. 7 M. which is the  $\frac{E}{4}$  of the Oregon State Highway No. 6 as now located, I ran S. 0° 15' W on said center line 10560 ft., where I set a flasher point, I then ran westerly at 90° angle to said  $\frac{E}{4}$  of highway at 50 ft. from said  $\frac{E}{4}$  I turned 90° angle and set a point on the W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  line of the highway at a dist. of 90 ft. North, and another at 60 ft. South, I then continued on westerly at Pt. A to  $\frac{E}{4}$  of Hwy. a dist. of 225 ft.; I then turned 90° and set a point a dist. of 90 ft. north and another at a dist. of 60 ft. south, which points are the corners of a tract sold by Enos D. Martin and Ira H. Martin to L. L. Crossman. These corners are marked with iron pins
