



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to establish the West line of a parcel belonging to Alex LeFore.

Researching the deeds we find that this line is described as being 165 feet East of the North-South centerline of Section 35. The North end of the line is 20 feet South of the centerline of Powell Road as established by Co. Surveyor Nos. B-1193-B, B-157-A and B-112-A.

The South end is on the North line of a parcel conveyed to Robert H. and Carol J. Tinker as described on Page 360 of Book 281 of the Deed Records of Umatilla County. A 3/4" iron pin was found as shown on the South end of the line 7.30 feet South of the true position.

Bearings are based on the call on North Main Street by Jim Dwyer of North 0°17'34" East.
