THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO STAKE LOT 19, BLOCK 13, NEWPORT ADDITION TO THE CITY OF HERMISTON, EXCEPTING THE SOUTH 100 FEET OF THE WEST 75 FEET THEREOF, IN PREPARATION OF A TOPOGRAPHY SURVEY FOR PINNACLE ARCHITECTURE SO THEY CAN DESIGN A STRUCTURE ON SAID PARCEL. THIS PARCEL IS DESCRIBED IN A DEED TO THE CITY OF HERMISTON ON REEL 374, PAGE 579, UMATILLA COUNTY DEED RECORDS.

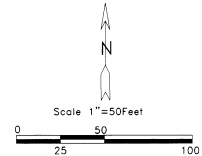
