



NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to mark the boundaries of a tract being purchased by Merle Mathwich. There is a fence around the tract and our pins were set on the outside of the fence. The South line of Section 18 was established by a stone marking the one-quarter corner and the Southeast corner of the Wells Survey for Woodroole, Tillman, and Geissel. The West line is a fence on which a boundary line agreement has been drawn.

There is some question as to the width of County Road No. 42, so we have not shown any.
