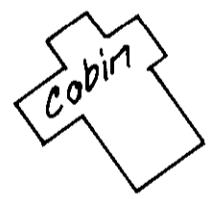

**NARRATIVE**

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a parcel belonging to Dan and Robert Humbert as described on Roll 113, Page 1587 of the Umatilla County Deed Records.  
The survey was based upon a survey for Mrs. Elliot, Co. Surveyor No. R-149B. The North quarter corner and other pins were found as shown. A traverse was run with a Wildt 11000 and the corners were set from a closed traverse.  
Bearings are based upon the Elliot survey and a James Hanley Survey, County Surveyor No. L-56-B.

- denotes 1/2" iron pin with 1 1/2" Dia. iron pipe along side, Umatilla County Surveyor No. G-751-B
