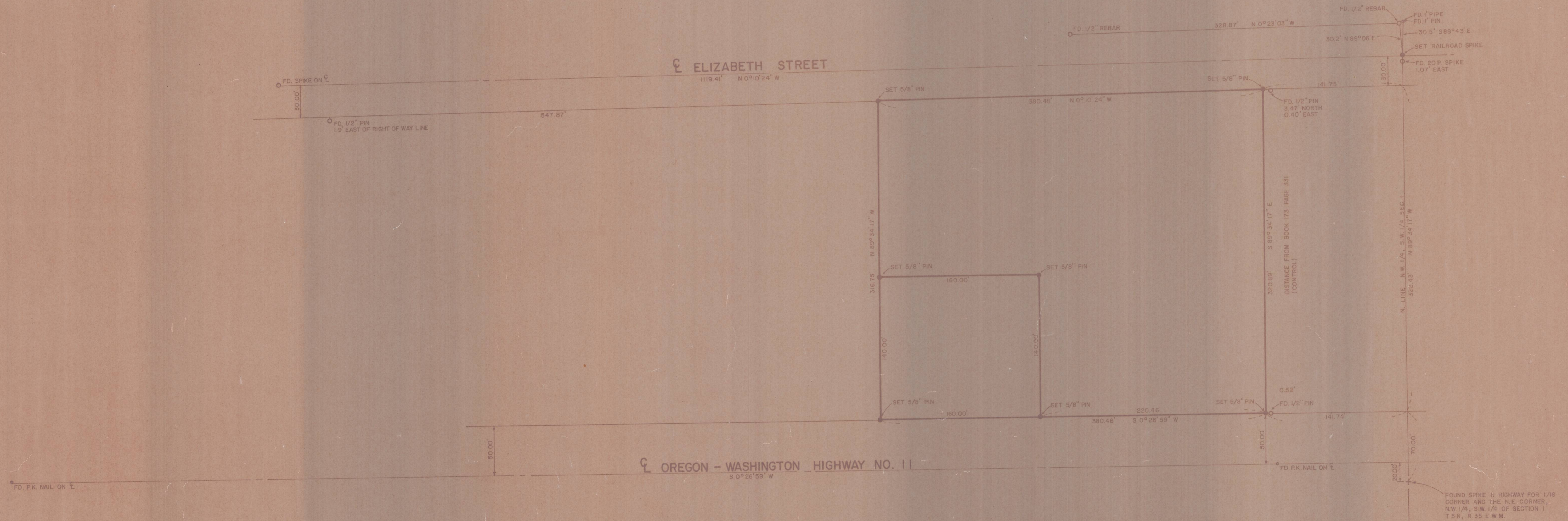

1. THERE WERE NO RECORDS TO BE FOUND IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S RECORDS OF ALL THE MONUMENTS FOUND ABOVE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE 1/16 CORNER, AND THE CONCRETE MONUMENT IN THE VALVE BOX. THOSE TWO MONUMENTS ARE SHOWN ON THE DWYER - LAUGHERY SURVEY DATED JANUARY 14, 1977.
2. THERE IS A G.M. NEWBILL SURVEY DATED 5-2-56 THAT ALSO SHOWS THE 1/16 CORNER AND 4 OTHER PINS SET, BUT A SEARCH DID NOT REVEAL ANY OF THE 4 PINS.
