To the County Court of Yamhill Co Oregon

We proceeded July the 19<sup>th</sup> 1873 in accordance with your order at the July term and in accordance with the Laws of Oregon to view the proposed change in the Linkton road near the residence of J. W. Lawrence. We believe that such change will be no detriment to the traveling public as the road is some shortened and the grade is but little increased by the change we therefore recommend its adoption

Field notes of the Survey to change the County road near the residence of J. W. Lawrence

Beginning at a post set in the center of the Linkton or County road and on the division line between the claims of J. W. Lawrence and O. W. Harkness

Thence according to the following courses and distances viz.

Chains  
24.80  
13.70  
2.03  
18.67  
21.58

South on the above division line variation 21° E  
Thence S 28° 30' E var 21° 15' E  
Point from which the corner for Sections 10, 11, 14 & 15 35<sup>th</sup> NR 36E  
Runs N 67° 15' E distant 14<sup>47</sup> chains Thence South  
Slight divide between the Mulla Mulla and Birch creek - descend  
Thence S 19° 45' E  
Intersect Linkton road, Bears North to Mulla Mulla and S 22° 35' W  
to Grand Round.
