

## Report, Survey and Plat of Road from A. J. Sturtevant's

to

Mouth of Jack Canyon

In the Honorable County Court of  
Wasatch County Oregon

In the matter of the location of a County Road from the store of A. J. Sturtevant to mouth of Jack Canyon we the undersigned viewers beg leave to report as follows The ground which said proposed road passes over is nearly level with the exception of one or two small gulches. The crossing of Birch Creek could be bettered by changing the road a distance of 20 feet on either side we would therefore recommend the road as practicable and of public utility and recommend the same to be opened and located as a County Road We would also recommend that the County Road on the West side of Birch Creek be vacated from the mouth of Jack Canyon to Sturtevant's store and that the County Road leading up the West fork of Birch Creek on the East side of said stream be not vacated but still remain a County Road For further particulars with regard to courses and distances we refer you the Surveyor's reports
