

Report Survey and Plat of Road from near Pierce's claim

To

Sinkton Road

To the Honorable County Court of Washtenaw County State of Oregon

The undersigned viewers appointed by your Honorable body July 7th 1875 to view out survey and otherwise mark a County Road commencing at a point on the public road running from the town of Milton to the timber on the Blue Mountains, near the S. E. corner of the Land claim of Nathan Pierce and following the wagon road as now cut out to the Sinkton Road, met July 17th 1875 at the farm of Mr. G. Berry and having been duly qualified and having called to our aid the necessary assistance we proceeded to view survey and otherwise mark said proposed road as directed by your Honorable body and do most respectfully recommend that said road be located and made a County road for the following reasons, 1st It would greatly accommodate the public traveling across the Blue Mountains, 2nd It would be of great utility to the community residing in the vicinity affording them a way by which they can draw timber from the mountains 3rd A large proportion of the proposed road is open and in good condition, and 4th your viewers are of opinion that the location is excellent for a mountain Road.
