on the 7th inst have after calling the necessary assistants as required
by law and all being duly sworn proceeded to view and have marked
out the route described in your order and as described and plotted
by G. J. Berry acting Surveyor whose report we transmit herewith
We have found the route a good practical one and recommend
that the same be made a County Road as viewed and surveyed

To the Honorable County Court of Washtenaw County, State of Oregon
Gentlemen. The undersigned having been appointed
by you to survey a route for a road from Milton to the State line
under the direction of James Lawrence Aaron Isaacs and G. J. Moss
as viewers has to report that after being duly sworn by J. E. Kirk
land J. P. and having administered to the above named viewers
and P. Nichols and James A. Smith as chainmen and Wm. Haseberg
as axemen the oath of their several offices as required by the
statutes of this State proceeded to survey and mark the following
route. Beginning at the end of the lane near the United States
Mills and running 15° E of N. E. 30 rods to near the mill race
thence 11° North of East 20 rods thence 15° E of N. E. 10 rods thence
30° N. of E. 10 rods thence 52° West of N. 10 rods thence 70° N. of E.
20 rods thence N. to the N. W. corner of the Fraziers land 50 rods
thence E. 80 to S. W. of Sec. 6 T. 5 N. of R. 36 East thence N. along
the section line one and one half miles to the S. W. corner of
James Pattersons land thence E. 80 rods thence North 75 rods
thence E. 320 rods at the place of beginning the viewers had
the axemen plant a post of durable wood four inches square
marked P. at the end of each mile be planted similar posts
marked as the law directs and made mounds four feet
