

Report. Survey and Plat of Road from Mountain Road

1878

Linkton Road

To the Hon County Court for Wasilla County State of Oregon
 We, the undersigned your appointed viewers
 in the matter of a road survey, preliminary to the establishment
 of a county road leading from the mountain road to the Linkton
 Road as prayed for in the petition signed by G. W. Stallcop and
 others, met at the house of G. W. Stallcop on Wednesday May 15
 a. d. 1878 and were duly qualified by Jno. C. Arnold Surveyor, and
 after taking to our assistance G. W. Stallcop as marker and
 Stallcop and Marion Stubblefield as chainbearers, who were
 qualified as aforesaid, proceeded to view and lay out said road as
 called for in the petition for the same: we find, upon careful
 examination, that said road would be quite on a practicable route,
 would be easily opened and kept in repair, and that it is very
 much needed as a public thoroughfare hence we recommend the
 location of said road by your Hon. body.

For our services we claim the legal fees.

Field Notes of Survey of County Road for
 Wasilla County Oregon.

Set initial sawed fir post 4x4 inches in
 mound of earth as required by law, on the West side of the main
 traveled Mountain road about 33 links N. of S E corner of Sec 10th
 & N R 36 E. S 36° W along section line 80 ch set 1 mile stake sawed
 fir 4x4 inches in mound of earth on top of hill and in Campbells
 field on N. - S 86° W on same course 21 ch 50 links set termina-
 ting post at intersection of Linkton Road 4x4 inches in mound
 of earth 33 links N of section line and on E side of the main
 traveled road known as Linkton Road. Surveyed May 15, a. d. 1878
