

Rd # 1
Act of County Road from
Umatilla City to Head of
Brick Creek

In accordance with an Order made by the Hon: County Court of Umatilla County at its Special October Term 1865. That Levi Reed, David Coffman & Benjamin Smith, Viewers & E. H. Nelson County Surveyor, should be notified to be & appear at Umatilla City on the first Monday the 4th day of December A.D. 1865. & proceed to view & lay a County Road commencing at Umatilla City & running thence up the Umatilla River over the main trawled Road to a point about half of a mile beyond the Four Mile House. Thence take the right hand Road known as Wardweas Wood Road, leading in a South East direction to the new bridge on James Wardweas Land Claim. Thence through James Wardweas Land Claim to the South West Corner of Alfred Jots Claim thence Eastward on the South side of a Jots pasture. Thence in a South East direction on the most practicable route to a school house in District No 5. Thence South upon Courtway line running North & South to the Corner of P. A. Brassfield & Doctor Peas Land Claim. Thence South through lands one half of a mile. Thence to run in a S. E. direction on the best route to Head of Upper Ranch in Spring or Alkali Hollow. Thence to Benjamin Smiths on West fork of Brick Creek Thence up East Brick Creek to intersect Dayley Road at or near Kuyers House. & report the doing thereof to the Court at its next Regular Session, due notice of which I had received. I proceeded to Umatilla City on Monday the 4th day of the month & met Levi Reed, & David Coffman, two of the Viewers who agree to commence said Road at the terminus of "G" Street Southern Boundary of Umatilla City where we set the first Stake. Not being able to procure Chairman & Mr Smith absent we adjourned until next morning. On Tuesday morning Dec 5th we could get but one Chairman. George Larson by name. David Coffman offered to act as Chairman & I administered the necessary oath to them. & proceeded according to the following field notes. Commencing at terminus of "G" Street. Southern boundary of City limits we ran.
