 Change of Road Milton to Dry Creek

Pueblo, Co. March 12 "1881,

We the undersigned Viewers appointed to view out and report on the proposed change in County Road from Milton to Dry Creek, met with J. W. Raley County Surveyor March 12 "1881, and after surveying and investigating said proposed change find it to be a practicable route and recommend that a County road be located on the Sec line, running north from the initial to intersection of the telegraph road.

Gentlemen; I submit the following as the notes taken in the survey made in view of the change in County Road from Milton to Dry Creek. Viewers having met and qualified on the 7th day of January as per Order. Adjourned to meet again on March 12 "1881, I having met with them on the last named day, proceeded to qualify S. J. Woodcock and Hamilton Gans as Chairman, after which as per order, we went to point where said road crosses the Section line between Sec 25 & 26 in T 5 N. R. 35 East. At which point I set a post marked "R" and ran North Var. 21° East as given by the Original Field Notes. North 80.00 chains to post marked "M.T." and raised mound as per instructions, at 160.00 set post marked "M.T." Raised mound as per instructions, at 163.00 chains I set post at intersection of Road from Milton to Dry Creek, marked post "R" for terminus of Road, Raised Mound 100 as per instructions.
