

Continuing north along Meavis place (Civi Grove) below fork to
 Butter Creek, then set 25th M. Post opposite (Civi Grove) crossing
 Big Butter Creek below the residence of late John P. Adams, deceased.
 Then run up hill S. E. and over on same course to Sauer Spring,
 and down flat 1/4 mile - thence S. East direct to New Bridge on Umaticus
 River Echo Summit, Making 22 1/2 miles last day - and whole distance
 through from Heppner to Echo Bridge 37 miles.

We therefore recommend this as a practicable route for a
 wagon road on the above named Civi and Sauer from Heppner to
 Echo Bridge, Umaticus River,
