 We the undersigned having been appointed by your Hon. body to view out and survey a change in the County Road in the above named County and state, would report that we met at the time and place appointed, and after being qualified according to law by A L Coffey County Surveyor, we called to our aid A. Hopson and D M Groom as chainmen and A Hopson as marker, we proceeded to view out and survey said change of road, to wit: Commencing at a point where the North line of Sec 7 T5. NR 36 E crosses the Linkton road, and surveyed said change on the line set forth in the petition, we would further report that the road is an good practicable route and is easily opened and kept in repair, we therefore would recommend that the petition be granted.
