To the Hon County Court for Umatilla County Oregon.

I hereby certify that on the 14th day of May 1884 after qualifying J. J. Baumgardner, G. Greene and W^m Coffman as Viewers, John Myers, G. C. Green as Chainmen, Walter Caviness as marker, I proceeded to survey of a County Road for the above County and State, as described in the accompanying field notes.

Beginning on line between Sec 35 & 36 T⁴ P 4 N. R 30 East, where County Road crosses said line running down what is known as Stage Canyon set post marked R. Run North on line between Sec 35 & 36. 25 & 26. 320 Rods set post, Miles One. Run North on same line 320 Rods set post Miles two. Run on line 320 Rods set post Miles 3. Run N. on same line 320 Rods set post Miles 4. Run North on line 320 Rods set post Miles 5. Run North on line 320 Rods T⁴ P 5 N. R 30 E. 320 Rods. set post Miles 6. Run North on line to the S. E. corner of Sec 26. 16 rods. Angle thence West on line between Sec 26 & 35. 160 Rods set post Miles 7. Run West on line 112 Rods. Angle thence North 35 degrees West, down Canyon to County Road in main Cold Spring Canyon 120 Rods set post marked R.
