Met J. S. Richey & Jno. B. Frazier viewers, A. A. Hammer & J. C. McKinnis
Chmn. ^{and} A. B. Evans marker, who were each duly qualified as req. by law.

I commence at N. W. cor. of Sec 27 & 6 & R. 35 E. a basalt stone
as deep as may be in ground, 19x10x8 ins. above ground at angle in line
N. & E. (Mud Creek Road) ^{and} run.

South on true line bet Secs. 27 & 28 va. - $21^{\circ} E$

40.50 chs The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec cor. bet. Secs 27 & 28

a basalt stone as deep as may be in ground
8x5x4 ins. above ground, old lines of fencing
run N. W & S. - old ditch runs N. - I angle

East on true line E & W through center Sec. 27

20.00.. Set a larch post 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins dia, marked R on N
side about 20 links S. E of point, for initial post

59.44 Int N. & S line at $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. bet. Secs 26 & 27. Set a larch
post 6 in dia marked R on W. side, for terminal post. - sand level
