To the Hon. County Court, Umatilla County, Oregon.

We, your viewers on Road No. 323, would respectfully report that we met County Surveyor Jno. C. Arnold, at time & place appointed for the same, & were each duly qualified, as directed by law to act as Road Viewers on said Road.

We called to our aid U. A. Ward & Augustus Rochel to act as chainmen & markers who were each duly qualified when we proceeded to survey & view out said road as prayed for in petition for the same.

We find the route a practical one, & the road much needed. We would, therefore, recommend that said Road 323, be declared a public highway.
