We the undersigned viewers would on County Road No 300 for Umatilla County Oregon would respectfully Report that we met with Jno Arnold County Surveyor at the time and place appointed by your Hon Body and proceeded to view out and survey said Road 300 We find the road located upon Section and Sectional subdivision lines and upon comparatively good ground, the road will be comparatively easy to open and keep in repair the road is much needed and we believe the grade north of Umatilla River to Baker's bridge on said river to be the best and most practical that can be found

We therefore recommend that said road be declared a Public Highway
