Report of Viewers, field notes and plat of survey of Road No 352 in Umatilla County, Oregon, Commencing at the cross West corner of Section 30 in Township 6. NR 35 E 10W, running thence South 8 rods and 3/2 ft, thence East 3/2 mile, thence South One fourth mile, thence East 1/2 mile, thence South 1/4 mile, thence East 3/4 mile m, or l, to intersection of a County Road leading from Milton Oregon to Hudson Bay known as the Hudson Bay Road.

Report of Viewers

To the Honorable County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

We the undersigned a majority of the viewers appointed by your Honorable body to view survey, locate and report on proposed road No 352 as prayed for by petition of J. C. Hodgson and (18) others beg leave to report to your Honorable body, that we met J. H. Lawrey surveyor at Milton on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1891 and duly qualified and calling to our aid J. W. Dykes and A. A. Adams as chainmen and markers who were duly qualified.

We proceeded to view, <sup>survey and</sup> locate said proposed road as directed by your Honorable Body and we most earnestly recommend that said road be established and opened as a County Road for the following reasons,

- 1<sup>st</sup> The location is good.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> There is no County road in the neighborhood the public being compelled to travel by ways through fields gates and bars and therefore said road would be of much public utility and is greatly needed.
