Report of Viewers, Field Notes and Plat of Survey of Road No 364, Umatilla County, Oregon,

Commencing 30 rods North of the Southeast corner of Section one (1) T 4 North R 35 E W.M., thence in a south-westerly direction about three fourths of one mile to intersect the County Road on Dry Creek in Umatilla Co. Or. This road is to pass over a road that has been traveled for several years, the object of this petition is to legalize said road.

Said Road to be sixty feet wide.

In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out County Road No. 364.

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County.

We, the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No. 364 submit the following report; Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met Jno. C. Arnold, Surveyor at Res. of Larkin Shippis on the 4th day of Aug. 1891, and were by him, each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointment;
