Report of viewers, field notes and Plat of Survey of
Road No 367, Umatilla County, Oregon,

Commencing at the County Road on Wild Horse Creek near
the center of Section 34 Tp 4 NR 34 E W M., running thence due
south between the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE quarter section 34 Tp. 4 NR 34 E W M.
thence south to west side of the O.R. & N. Co's Rail Road R of W,
thence running south west on west side of Railroad
until parallel with Commercial Street in Goldmans
Addition to the town of Adams, running thence west
to corner of Commercial and Main Streets running
thence ~~South~~ on Main Street to Wild Horse Creek,
thence South to Railroad R of W, thence South west on west
side of Railroad to the Wild Horse Creek, thence in a
south westerly direction on east side of said Creek to
the North west corner of Southeast quarter of Section
nine (9) in Township Three (3) North of Range 34 E W M.
thence south on line to section line between
sections 9 and 16, thence West on said section line
to the NW corner of Sections 8-9-16th & 17, Thence south
one mile to section corner of Sections 16-17-20 and 21,
thence west on section line to the section corner of sections
17-18-19th & 20, thence south on section line to sections cor-
ner of Sections 19-20-29th & 30, thence west on section
lines $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the quarter post between the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 23 Tp 3 NR. 33 E W M., thence north as near on
line as practicable to Kavana Station on the O.R
& N. Co. Railroad, thence up Wild Horse Creek to inter-
sect County Road running north on half mile line
in said Section 23 Tp 3 NR. 33 E W M. ~~Yours~~
Said Road to be 60 feet wide.
