In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out
county Road no. 372

Commencing 10 rds W of the center of sec. 4 T5 SR 32 E & E.
th due E about 100 rds, th S down a canon about 80 rds to the
N side of Camas creek th up Camas creek about 50 rds to the
mouth of cable creek, cross camas creek above the mouth of
cable creek, th up cable creek about 40 rds, th in a S E direction
across the N W 1/4 Sec 10 T5. SR 32 E. to a point 80 rds due E
of the center of sec 10 T5. SR 32 E. th due E 3/4 mile. th S E direction
to a point 80 rds S of the 1/4 Sec stake E + W line in Sec. 18. T5. SR 32
E th E 1/4 mile, th S 1/4 mile th E 1/4 mile, th S E 20 rds, th E to a point
30 rds E of the 1/4 mile stake on the S line of sec 16. T5. SR 33 E,
th N E to the head of Butcher Knife ^{and down said canon} to a point 10 S
and 80 rds W of center of sec 2 T5 SR 33 E. th E 1/2 mile. th N 10
rds, th E to a point on Warm Springs Creek 10 rds W of the
center of sec 1. T5. SR 33 E. W.M. said road to be 40 feet wide.

Report of Viewers

To the Honorable County Court. of the state of Oregon
for Wasatch County:

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to
view and locate Road No 372 Submit the following report
Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court We met pro.
C. Arnold County Surveyor, at Alba on the 25th day of June
1892 and were by him, each, duly sworn to faithfully
and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid Arthur Moore } chairmen
Harry Ritner }
Marken

who were by the surveyor, each, duly sworn. we viewed,
surveyed and located said Road no. 372 Three hundred and
seventy two as specified in our order We find the route prac-
-ticable, passing through a place where there is no other county
road, and the road very much used by the citizens in its
vicinity, as well as by the Public in general. We would, therefore
recommend, that said road no. 372 be declared a public highway.
