

Field Notes of Road Survey No 415 for Unmatilla Co. Ogn.

I meet John A. Davis and J. L. Ward Viewers on road Survey No 415 for Unmatilla Co. Or. at Res of Edwin Reeser March 3<sup>d</sup> 1893 and call Michael Tomer and Edwin Reeser to chain and same Drumheller to mark each of whom were sworn as per law after which under direction of the said Viewers, I set initial road post 17 ft E. of a pt in angle of road in lane course S+W which point purports being the 1/4 Sec. cor. on W 1/2 of line run E+W through Center of Sec. 14 T. 6 N. R. 36 E. I run from said pt. along fence purporting to be on line N+S, through Center of NW 1/4 said Sec. 14

Va. 18° E.

It.

No. Fence on N. side of lane at angle S+W.

1340. " runs E. (gate for passway)

2576. a pt. brds. S. of purporting line bet. Secs. 13+14.

Marked by a rail fence. I set angle post MKd. 1 against N+S. fence, and turn N. 60° W.

2775 a Rail fence runs E+W

2972 a pt. brds. N. of Cor. of fences E+N, - I set angle post MKd. 2 against N+S. fence and turns North

3400 Center of Spring branch in ravine about 40 ft. Wide x 6 ft. deep.

3533 Fence runs W.

3731 Set angle post MKd. 3 against N+S. fences and turn across N.E. Cor. of Antons Eeffingers field N. 58°. 05' W.

4550 Fence on S. side of lane, course E+W.

4600 Set turnings against fence on N. side of said lane all the posts are of regulation size and are marked and set in mounds as required by law.
