

Field notes of Road Survey No 420 for Unadilla Co. Or.

I meet Ellis Simons, David Howdyshell and A. J. Perkins Viewers on Road No 410 and call Edgar Thomson and James Trobaugh to chain and mark, I administer to each the usual oath, after which under direction of said Viewers I set initial post against fence on south side of lane bearing E + W. 52 ft. wide and about 32 ft. South of the 14 Sec. Cor. bet. Sec 18 + 19 T3 N. R 34 E. and from said 14 Sec. Cor. I run on line through center said Sec. 14.

- 00 ft. Fence on N side of road in lane E + W
 - 1970.. Second hill.
 - 4120.. Jas. Trobaugh's house, bears west about 150 ft.
 - 4170.. Fence E. + W. Leave field.
 - 4350.. center of road in lane course about N 80° W + S. 80° E. Down Deepain Gulch - Ascend.
 - 4370.. N. side of said lane set terminus 29 feet. E. against fence on E. side of lane course N + S.
- all the posts are of regulation size and are correctly marked and set in mounds, and no part of said road need to exceed a 10% grade
