

Field notes of Road Survey No 423 for Umatilla County Oregon.

I met Geo Ruzan and Frank Brown. Viewers on Road Survey No 423 for Umatilla Co Or. at Rec of W. H. McCormack June 10th 1893 and administer usual Oath to each, We call E. R. Thomson and W. H. McCormack to chain and mark, each duly qualify as per law.

I set initial post against fence on N. side of lane, at angle in same E & W. and 15' N. of the probable Cor. of Sec's 14, 15, 22, & 23 Sp 3 NR 336^E and from said Cor. point, I run along probable line bet Sec's 14 & 23 fence 15' to L:

1043 Set ang. p. mtd \uparrow against fence post at jog in E & W. fence. $\xrightarrow{\text{W Fence}}$ $\xrightarrow{\text{E Fence}}$ and turn R. 90°

South

Descending gently through W. H. McCormack's field of growing wheat.

2250 Foot of descent. Centre of small Ravine
Course S. Ascend. gently.

2384 A pt in centre of lane, course E & W. taken as terminus to Road No. 423

Set post 23. NW against fence on N. side of said lane.

All the posts used are of regulation size and correctly marked, and set in mounds.
