Viewers Report

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon.
for Umatilla County.

We, the Undersigned, the Viewers heretofore
appointed to view and locate Road No 430, submit
the following report. Pursuant to an order
of the Honorable Court we met Jno. C. Arnold
County Surveyor, at Bendleton, Oregon on June
24th 1893, and were by him, each duly sworn
to faithfully and impartially discharge the
duties of our appointments.

We call to our aid V.L. Burnham, Ed R
Thomson. Channman's Marker, who were by the
Surveyor, each duly sworn, We Viewed, surveyed,
and located said Road No 430, as specified in
our Order, that the route is a practicable one,
that is compared with the Road now in use
the distance between the City of Bendleton, and
the McKay Creek Bridge is much shorter,
and the grades materially lessened.

We therefore Recommend that said Road
No 430 be declared a public highway.

begin at a pt about 77 Rods West of the NE Cor
of Section 16 T² R³² E² W², said point being where
the North line of said Sec 16 intersects County Road
No 397, and Running thence in a Southwesterly
direction following the old Road as now traveled
across said Section 16, and ending at a point
where the said Old Road now intersects County
Road No 397, said point being at angle Stake No
21 on said Road No 397 in the E² SW² Sec 16 T²
R³² E² W². Said Road to be 60 feet wide.
