

Field Notes of Road Survey No. 437, Umatilla County, Oregon

Pursuant to notice I met A. M. Elam, Henry L. Frazier and Geo. De Haven, viewers appointed on the road survey No 473 for Umatilla County, Oregon, at the Bartlett House, in Milton, Oregon, at 8 a.m. May 28, 1894.

The said viewers qualify according to law after which H. M. Palmer and J. S. Ritchey were called and sworn, as chairman

Under direction of said viewers, I commence at a point 550 ft N and 30 ft E of the 1/6 sec cor on the N 1/2 of line between sec 1 & 17 T. 5 N. R. 35, said point being in the center of the channel of the Little Walla Walla River. I drive a post mkd R 437 on S bank of said river, course N 15 ft of said pt of commencing and cut R 437 on N.W. of cottonwood tree 12 ins dia., used for post in wire fence, 93 ft south of point of commencing and run on line, parallel to the line running N 1/4 S through the center of the S. N 1/4 of said sec 1.

North

- 15 ft North bank of Little W. W. River 30' wide runs west.
- 100.. Corner fences 1st & E.
- 159.. " " " " E
- 560.. Irrigating ditch 1' x 3', course N.W.
- 950.. Spring branch 6' wide " "
- 1305.. Fence bars E. 2nd W.
- 1781.. Cor. fences E 3rd N.
- 2135.. Set 1 in middle of branch, 42 1/2 ft N.E. of stone 1/6 sec cor, on W 1/2 of line E 3rd W through center of said sec 1, and turn, change S 90° 50' on line parallel to said center section line.

West

- 2310.. E bank of branch, course N.
- 2330.. W " " " " " "
- 2495.. S.E. cor of dwelling house hrs. 10 1/2 S of line.
- 2555.. Int N 3rd S fence on E side of road leading from Milton to W. W. - I drive post and mark fence at pt of intersection, and 60 ft S of this P.D. I set a sawed fir post 4x4 ins., 4 ft long, 18 inches in ground for terminus to road No 437. Raised stone md. 4 ft base and 2 ft high around post, and stake out the same the W sides of said road, as per order of the Hon. Court
