In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out county road No 461

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No 461, submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, We met John W Kimbrell, surveyor, at Helix Postoffice, on the 1st day of August, 1895, and were by him each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid Geary Kimbrell, and J Caplinger, chairman, and Alvin Knight, marker, who were by the surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No 461 as specified in our order, and find the route practicable and would most respectfully recommend the same to be declared a public highway

Dited notice Road Survey No 461

I commenced at the SE corner of sec 36 in T50N R. 33E W 2M

Set Post 4 feet long and 4 inches square 20 feet south of the initial point, Marked D No 461 on north face, dug pits East and west and raised mound 4 feet wide at base and 18 inches high around post.

Table with columns: Chains, Distance, and bearings. Rows include 'Thence Drum' and 'West' with measurements like 4594, 4594, 2675, 7269, 731, 80.00, 1 mile.

Set Post 4 feet long and 4 inches square 20 feet north of center of Road, marked 1 m on south face, built mound 4 feet wide at base and 18 inches high around post

Table with columns: Thence, West, and bearings. Rows include 'Thence on sec line' with measurements like 37.75, 114.75, 37.65, 152.40, 4.04, 156.84, and 'Road Terminus'.

Set Post 4 feet long and 4 inches square 30 feet north of Terminus and 300 links west of the SE corner of Sec 2, in T40N R 34 E W 2M

Built mound 4 feet wide at base and 18 inches high around post, dug pits north and west of Post
