We, the undersigned, the jurors appointed to view and locate Road No 482
submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable
Court we met John W Kimbrell, Surveyor, at commencement of
Road on the 24th day of Sept. 1896, and were by him each duly sworn
to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appoint-
ments.

We called to our aid G O French, G A Shockey, Chairmen,
James Shockey, Marker, who were by the surveyor each duly sworn
We viewed surveyed and located said Road No 482 as specified in
our order, and find the route practicable, and would most respect-
fully recommend the same be established and declared a public
highway of Umatilla County, Oregon.

Field Notes of County Road No 482

I met Robert Albee, J M Coffey and Thomas Jacques, Viewers, at
the beginning of the above road to each of whom I administered
the usual oath, and we called to our assistance G O French, and
G A Shockey, as chairmen, and James Shockey as marker, who
were each by me duly qualified as by law required.

I commenced at a point 750 chains west of the S E corner of
Sec 27 in T 1 N R 32 E N M., set post 4 feet long and 4 inches
square & 45° E 47 the distant from the initial point marked R No
482, dug pits east and south of post and made mound 18 inches
high and 4 feet wide at base

1	Thence	North	3900	5650	PT at the NE corner of the SE 1/4

Sec 27 in T 1 N R 32 E N M., set post 4 feet long and 4 inches square
30 feet East of terminus of Road Marked R No 482, dug pits south and
East of post and raised mound 18 inches high and 4 feet wide at
base.
