

Field Notes of County Road No 481.

I met Roll O'Brian, Robert Kudepeth and John Herndon, view-ers, at the residence of A F Taylor, on the 21st day of November, 1896 as per order of the county court of Umatilla County, Oregon. Each of the view-ers being duly sworn by me we called to our assistance Mat Erb and Jack Biergart, as Chaimmen and C. Johnson as marker, and after each were duly sworn we proceeded to lay out and survey road No 481.

Commencing at the "4 Section corner between Secs 3+4 in T3 N29 36 E R11 as the initial point, I set a post 4 inches square 4 feet long marked R481, dug pits and raised mound 18 inches high and 4 feet wide
