In accordance with instructions issued by the Hon. County Court of Umatilla County, at their July term, appointing Viewers and Surveyor, to locate, to locate and survey Road # 528, on the 24. day of July A.D. 1901. I met J.W. Sturdivant and Rod McDonald, Viewers appointed by the County Court to view and locate said Road # 528, at which Umatilla County Oregon, Jacob Barn the 3<sup>rd</sup> Viewer was excused from duty as pressing business called him away.

We called to our aid D.E. Coombs, and J.E. Beant as Viewers as chairman and marker and after duly qualifying all, we proceeded to the initial point of Survey, and proceeded to view locate and survey Road # 528.

Field notes of survey of Road # 528. Survey made July 24, 1901. Beginning at a stone, the "4" sec. corner between sections 21 & 28, T<sub>5</sub> S. Range 32, E.W.M. at which point I take an observation of the Sun to establish true north, set past 20' south, as per just marked. R 528.
