KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we N A Steen a widow, C W St-en and Rose Steen his wife, W H Steen and Beryl Steen his wife, Grace Steen an unmarried woman, each for themselves and C W Steen as guardian for Grant Steen a minor, being the heirs at law and the only heirs at law of Wm. Steen deceased, for the consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to us paid have bargained, sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Umatilla County, State of Oregon, a strip of land sixty feet wide for road purposes, being thirty feet on either side of the following described line to-wit: BEGINNING at a point 586 feet South of the Northeast corner of the northwest quarter of section 27 in Township 5 North, of Range 35 E³⁵ W³⁵, thence Northeasterly 1316 feet to a point 164 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 27 in Township 5 North of Range 35 E³⁵ W³⁵.

It being understood that this conveyance is intended to cover the road as now opened and same has been opened and traveled for more than three yea spast

To have and to hold the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said Umatilla County forever.

And we the said grantors herein do hereby covenant to and with the said umatilla County that we are the owners of the said premises, that we will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever,
