## REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

In the Matter of Viewing, Surveying and Laying Out County Road No. 578 To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view, survey and locate Road No 578 submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at County surveyors office in Pendleton Oregon on the 23 day of April 1906, we called to our aid

who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No 578 as specified in our order. We find said route practicable except the 1st 1/4 mile from starting point which we omit and commence at the center of E1/2 Sec 16 and would most respectfully recommend the route as platted and shown on the accompanying plat and field notes be established as a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The expense of opening the same to public travel will be about Two Hundred Dollars

## FIELD NOTES AND PLAT OF SURVEY OF ROAD NO. 580

COMMENCING at the SE corner of Sec 8 in T 3 N R 28 EWM, I set stake 4X4 inch 4 feet long 30 feet west of corner marked R No 580, made mound of earth 18 inch high 4 ft wide at post, thence North 80.00 1 mile set stake 4X4 inches 4 feet long 30 feet West of point marked A1, 1 M, built mound of earth 18 inch high 4 feet wide at post, dug pits N & S of post, thence east 40.00 A 2 thence North 40 -80.00 set post 4X4 inches 4 feet long 30 feet West of line marked 2 M, thence North 43.65 Irrigation ditch 30 feet wide course West 80.00 set post 4X4 inches 4 feet long 30 feet East of line marked 3 M rt 580, dug pits N & S and built mound of earth 18 inch high 4 feet wide at the base.
