Thence North 80.00 chains set post 4x4 inches 3 1/2 feet long 20 feet to the Right marked 1.M. and raised Mound 18 ins high 4 feet base around post, thence North 7,00 chains to the N.W. corner of section 7, T. 1 N.R. 32 E.W.M. set post 4x4 inches 3 1/2 feet long 20 feet to the west of terminus, Marked R.T. No. 761 and raised mound, of earth 18 inches high 4 feet base around post.
