I submit the following as the notes of the Survey of Road No. 774.

Began at the N. W. cor. of Sec. 1, T. 6 S.; R. 31 E. W. M., which is a large stone marked C. C. with a stone mound around it. Marked a fence post at above stone R. 774. Ran thence East 350.0 feet to center of a road.

5045.0 " cor. of Sections 35 & 36 on the First Standard Parallel South.
5280.0 " Marked telephone post, 40 ft. north, M. I.
5319.0 " North East cor. of Sec. 1, T. 6 S.; R. 31 E. W. M. a large stone and stone mound, and Forest Reserve Boundary post, marked post R. 774.
