PARSONS, Husband and Wife, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to them paid by WALLA WALLA COUNTY, State of Washington, a Public Corporation, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said WALLA WALLA COUNTY, State of Washington, a Public Corporation, its successors and assigns all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, situated in Walla Walla County, State of Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

A 10 foot strip of land across the South Boundary of the following tract:

Beginning at a point in the East line of Section 14 in Township 6 North, of Range 35 East of the Willamette Meridian, which point is 845.08 feet South, measured along said East line, from the Northeast corner of said Section 14, and running thence South, along said East line, a distance of 934.37 feet to the center of the County Road running East and West along the Oregon-Washington State Line; thence West, along the center line of said State Line road, a distance of 372.963 feet; thence North, parallel to the East line of said Section 14, a distance of 934.37 feet; thence East 372.963 feet to the point of beginning.
