Simmons at \$25⁰⁰, to the lands of W. Davis, at \$15⁰⁰ to the lands of Chris C. Watson at \$5⁰⁰ and the matter coming up for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day said road being described as follows, to-wit, commencing at the Southeast corner of the SW 1/4 of Sec 15, in Tp. 6 N. of Range 35 E W 7. running thence north through said section 15 about 53⁰⁰ to chains to intersection of the line between the State of Oregon and the State of Washington.

And the said Viewers having reported favorably, and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road and the field notes, and plat of survey, being duly on file, and certified to by Surveyor appointed to Survey the same.
