

479 Field Notes of Road Survey No. 479

I commenced at the SW corner of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec 23 in T 6 N R. 35 E W 1/4

I set Post 4 feet long and 4 inches square 20 feet west of Initial Point marked R. 479 dug pits and raised mound around Post set 18 inches in the ground & hence I run East through the center of the NW 1/4 Sec 23 nor 21° 15' E and at 40.66 chains to the center of the N 1/2 Sec 23 in T 6 N R 35 E W 1/4. Set Post 4x4 inches and 4 feet long 20 feet north and 20 feet west of Point of Terminus marked R.T. No. 479. Dug pits and built mound of earth around Post as required by law
