In Matter of County Road from Cross
Crossing to Peppers Crossing of Kalla Kalla River

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers appointed on the 24th day of January 1882 by this Court to view and assess as to damages sustained by E. D. Stillman by the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road, which said report of said viewers so appointed does not award any damage to said E. D. Stillman to the N¹/₂ S¹/₂ sec 1 T. 5. N. R. 35 E. by the location of said proposed location of a County Road above mentioned over said lands. And the report of the viewers appointed by the Court to view out and locate said road as a County Road having reported favorably upon the location of said proposed road as a County Road and said report having been previously read in open Court at a term of this Court last Sept term 1881 and now on this day comes on for final hearing and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file & duly certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same. It is therefore ordered by the Court that the prayer of said Petitioner herein be granted and that said road be established & created as a County Road in accordance with the Report of said viewers, and that the report field notes and plat of Survey be recorded as by law required.

In the Matter of County Road from
State Line at a point near the Home of R
Hills to the Farm of Milton

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed by this Court to view and report upon the proposed location of the above mentioned road as a County Road, which said report is this day read in open Court & recommends the establishing of said Road as a County Road. Also comes the Petition of Mary A. Stillman appearing by her attorney L. B. Cox claiming damage by the location & establishment of said proposed road to the S¹/₂ S¹/₂ sec 2 T. 5 N. R. 35 E. in the sum of \$300⁰⁰ and praying the Court that viewers may be appointed to view & estimate as to damage sustained by said Mary A. Stillman to said lands. It is therefore ordered by the Court that Samuel R. Cox
