Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the County Board of Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the February term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed road, said report having been ~~filed~~ filed on February 21, 1920, and publicly read the first time on March, 4, 1920, and publicly read the second time on March 5, 1920; and said Board having reported favorably, and recommended that said road be established as a public highway of Umatilla County; and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of public utility, and there being no remonstrances or objections on file to said report,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said report be adopted and approved, and that the same be opened for public use as soon as the damages in the sum of \$²200.00, accrued against the owner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 6, North, Range 35 E.W.M. be paid by the petitioners; that said report be recorded in the record of Plat and Field notes of Umatilla County.
